



Project Overview

Purpose: Traffic calming improvements to reduce vehicular speeds, improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety.

Project improvements: roadway widening and reconstruction, milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements, constructing a ten-foot shared-use path on the east side of the roadway and a five-foot sidewalk on the west side, driveway reconstruction, bus stop access, Lake Worth Drainage District Canal improvements, pedestrian crossing enhancement, and pedestrian lighting infrastructure along the newly constructed sidewalks.

Construction Start Date: June 3, 2024

Completion Date: Summer 2026

Estimated Construction Cost: \$7.8 million

Scope of Work – Roadway and Pedestrian Improvements

Roadway Improvements

- Roadway widening and reconstruction
- Milling and paving the existing roadway
- Drainage Improvements
- Improving L-32 and L-33 Canals
- Driveway reconstruction

Pedestrian Improvements

- Constructing a ten-foot shared-use path on the east side of the roadway
- Constructing a five-foot sidewalk on the west side of the roadway
- Bus Stop improvements
- Pedestrian crossing enhancements
- Installing lighting infrastructure along the newly constructed sidewalks

Construction Phases

Phase 1

- Drainage Improvements at Lake Worth Drainage District Canal L-32 (east and west).
- Install temporary roadway pavement between L-33 Canal and Barrett Street for east side drainage installations.
- Install temporary roadway pavement between Atlantic Avenue and LWDD L-33 Canal for west side drainage installations.

Phase 2

Complete drainage, widening and sidewalk construction working southbound from Lake
Ida Road along the west side of the roadway until reaching Atlantic Avenue, then heading
in the northbound direction on the east side of the roadway back to Lake Ida Road.

Phase 3

Mill and resurface the roadway, sign installations, and pavement markings.

Construction Working Hours

7:00 AM to 6:00 PM – Monday Through Friday

Lane Closures / Flagging Operations

- 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM Monday Through Friday, exception in the school zone of Carver Middle School
- During these times one thru lane will remain open though may be controlled with flagging operations.

Irrigation and Driveways

Advance Notice

- Residents are notified that construction is commencing on June 3, 2024.
- Residents will be notified in advance with door hangers of work near their homes.

During Construction


- Irrigation lines extending into the public right of way will be cut and capped. Residents
 wishing to make their own modifications may do so at any time in advance.
- Right-of-way stakes will be installed for homeowner reference (wood stake with orange flag). All plants, vegetation, and personal items in the public right of way should be removed by the property owner in advance.
- Driveway access impacted as part of construction will be restored daily by the Contractor.
- Additional notifications will be provided for driveway reconstruction and sidewalk installation operations.
